

**WRSR Lifeguard Camp**  
**Thursday June 1 – Sunday June 4, 2017**

**Will Rogers Scout Reservation (Cleveland, OK)**

**What? -** BSA Lifeguard and Red Cross Lifeguard Certification. Adults and youth (15+) wanting to be certified as a lifeguard will want to attend. Participants will also be certified in CPR and First Aid. This is class moves fast and is very physically challenging. It is preferred for scouts to have swimming merit badge, lifesaving merit badge and canoeing merit badge. Adults wanting to attend should have knowledge of these merit badges as well. The skills these merit badges teach are built on during the lifeguard course.

**When? -** Course begins Thursday June 1 with check-in at 6 pm. (please eat dinner before camp) Course continues with morning, afternoon and evening sessions through Sunday, June 4 at noon. We will be starting class at 6:00 pm on Thursday so please be at camp and have your camp set up and ready by 6:00.

**Where? -** Will Rogers Scout Reservation is located about 4.5 miles west of Cleveland, OK on the north side of Highway 64. From Highway 412, exit Cimarron Turnpike at Hallett, OK and proceed north on Highway 99. Will Rogers SR is about 1 mile east of junction of Highway 99 and Highway 64.

**Cost? -** \$125 course fee includes all program supplies, Red Cross Lifeguard Fee, BSA Lifeguard patch, CPR mask and a lifeguard whistle. It also includes all meals from Thursday breakfast through Saturday lunch. There is an additional \$18 fee to register non-scouts for insurance purposes.

**Registration? -** Complete and return registration form to Council Office by Wednesday May 21 ( \$15 late fee if received after this date) . Campers must submit at check-in a copy of Parts A, B & C of the Annual Health and Medical Record that includes a pre-participation physical. **Course Completion:**

Participants will be required to complete all requirements prior to receiving certification card. There will be a test for both certifications The test consists of written exams and skill drills in the water. BSA Lifeguard will require supervised guarding hours. First Year Camper Mini Camp (June 7-10 will be the best opportunity for you to complete hours needed)
