**Boy Scout Rescue Skills Weekend**

What? This weekend is designed to teach survival and safety skills all scouts need. This years focus will be on search and rescue skills. During the weekend scouts will be able to work on earning the new search and rescue merit badge, first aid merit badge and Scouts working on Search and Rescue will only complete one Merit Badge. Scouts not working on Search and Rescue will do Finger Printing Merit Badge on Friday and do First Aid on Saturday (these scouts will complete 2 merit badges).

Participation? All registered Boy Scouts may attend this event. . All participants (Scout,Leaders) will need to have a Health Form (Part A and B) on file.

Pre- registration will need to be turned in to the Scout office by Friday March 31, 2017.  
Late registration received after March 31 will have a \$5 late registration fee added to each registration.  
*This is due to placing food orders and material orders in advance based on early registration having to buy more supplies at the last minute is a huge expense.*

### Tough Boy Scout 2016 Schedule

Boy Scouts will be camping in Staff Area and using wall tents. If they wish to sleep in their own tents we will have an area set aside for them to set their sent up in for the weekend. Flashlights, walking shoes, and water bottle, physicals and any personal gear are needed. Open toed shoes are not allowed on camp. Scouts will need to bring pen and paper. Scouts Taking Search and Rescue Merit Badge will need to do Requirement 5 prior to arrival at camp and bring a blue card with this requirement marked as completed. Competing Req. 5 for SAR, this means all participants must complete the ICS-100 now IS-100.B online at <https://training.fema.gov>. Please print off the certificate that you will receive at the end of the ICS online training and bring it w ith you to camp. Also all SAR participants need to bring this additional equipment: Daypack, w ater bottle, canteen, first aid kit, a GPS device, if you have one or can borrow one. (do not rely on a cell phone. The service at camp is spotty.)
