

**Wilderness and Remote First Aid**  
**April 6-8, 2018**  
**Williams Scout Reservation**

**When?** April 6-8, 2018. Camp will be open in the afternoon for you to set up your campsite. Course work will begin at 6:00 pm on April 6<sup>th</sup>. All classroom work will be conducted in the dining hall. Outside classwork may be at any location on the camp!

**Where?** Williams SR is located 3 miles south of Highway 412. Turn-off is 9 miles west of junction with Highway 58 near Ringwood or 2 miles east of junction with Highway 8 (Cleo Springs-Aline turn-off). Look for a tall cell tower on north and Camp Williams sign on the south side of the highway. Turn south and drive down paved road 3 miles until you run into the camp entrance (take the driveway to the left of the Williams Scout Reservation sign).

**Who?** Youth 14 years old (on or before April 1, 2018) and Adults; Current CPR/AED certification is required.

**Cost?** EXPECTED FEE—should not exceed \$50.00 and will include your Red Cross certification, meals and misc. Actual fee should be less. When the actual fee is determined (which will be at camp that weekend) you will be advised so bring your checkbook or cash (small bills appreciated) to pay the fee.

**What?** This will be a fun weekend and the course is required for those attending BSA High Adventure locations. This is a 16 hour course. You need to be there for the entire course.

**Important:** You must bring a personal and group first aid kit. Be prepared for your clothes and other items to get dirty and perhaps stained (blood can be difficult to wash out).

**YOU MUST OBTAIN AND READ THE WILDERNESS AND REMOTE FIRST AID EMERGENCY REFERENCE GUIDE *BEFORE*, you get to camp. You will acquire more skills during the scenarios than in a classroom!**

Also bring with you a backpack packed with items you would normally take with you on a multiday hiking trip (you never know what you may have to use to deal with a wilderness or remote injury).

**FOOD, FOOD, FOOD.** Very importantly, we will feed you very, very well. Cracker barrel on Friday night, three meals on Saturday, breakfast and lunch on Sunday.
