Who: This course is for adults, ages 21+. Children or scouts will not be allowed to be at camp during Shooting Sports Training Events.

What: NRA Basic Range Safety Officer Training

This course is an NRA instructor level certification. It is encouraged to have NRA membership, but is not required.

When: Friday, June 8 to Sunday, June 10, 2018

Where: Williams Scout Reservation

Williams SR is located 3 miles south of Highway 412. Turn-off is 9 miles west of junction with Highway 58 near Ringwood or 2 miles east of junction with Highway 8 (Cleo Springs-Aline turn-off). Look for a tall cell tower on north and Camp Williams sign on the south side of the highway. Turn south and drive down paved road 3 miles until you run into the camp entrance.

Cost: \$75.00 per participant. Cost includes training materials & lunch and dinner on Saturday, breakfast on Sunday. NRA memberships fees are not included in this fee.

Registration is due by 4:30 pm Friday, May 25, 2018 to the Council Office.

Equipment: Participants will be overnight camping. Be prepared as necessary. No personal firearms or ammunition will be allowed.

Uniform: Participants should wear BSA Class A (field) during class time. Proper range attire is required. (Closed toe shoes, eye protection, cap, hearing protection).
