

## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE APPLICATION

The Cimarron Council believes that every scout should have the opportunity to participate fully in the Scouting program. The Council has limited provisions to help deserving scouts and their families offset the costs of registration, activity fees, camp attendance and uniforms. The Scout Law states that a scout is thrifty. This means a scout and their family should make every effort to earn as much of the fees as possible. In most cases, financial assistance will amount to one-half of applicable fees or costs. Financial assistance to individual scouts will be considered only upon receipt of application from registered members of the Cimarron Council and will be granted only for Cimarron Council-sponsored events and activities, registration, and Scout Shop merchandise.

Applications should be forwarded to the Cimarron Council office (317 N Grand, Enid, OK 73701) for consideration. Applications requesting assistance for a specific event or activity need to be turned in on or before the date when registration fees for that event or activity are due. Application must be signed by a parent or guardian. All information will remain confidential.
